The 2014 VZ (Van Zellers) is an old-vines (50-80 years) field blend. It comes in at 13% alcohol. Aged for eight months in French barriques (60% new and 40% one year old), it handles its oak beautifully, feels full bodied, nicely concentrated and well focused. I'm not quite sure it as yet matches the 2013 reviewed last year. This 2014 may be a bit livelier, but a bit less concentrated. Once it settles down, I suspect there won't be much in the way of qualitative differences, but there will be those style differences. It should age nicely for most of the next decade, maybe more. It is a bit on the pricey side, but that is no doubt explained in part by this: there were just 2,382 bottles and 53 magnums produced. Cristiano van Zeller, happily, has an array of importers around the country. They generally operate in their specific regions and not everyone may carry everything.
