The 2012 Torralvo is pure Tempranillo from a traditional head-pruned, 62-year-old vineyard in the village of Mambrilla de Castrejón. It fermented in small vats with indigenous yeasts and matured in oak barrels for some 18 months. It felt a bit closed at first, presenting serious, harmonious and elegant but powerful character like a sleeping lion. The nose is subtle with some oak-related aromas of sweet spices, ripe small berries and some earthy hints. The palate has tremendous balance, and feels polished with sleek tannins and good acidity to provide freshness and length. It has all the components for a long development in the bottle. Another superb Torralvo. 4,500 bottles produced. Great showing again of the wines for Juan Carlos Vizcarra.
