A significant step up over the more straightforward Les Ribes du Vallat, the 2014 Cotes du Ventoux la Terre du Petit Homme checks in as a blend of equal parts Grenache and Syrah that had the Grenache aged in stainless steel and the Syrah in barrel. It has gorgeous purity in its cassis, black raspberry, loamy earth and Provencal herb scented bouquet. This carries to a medium-bodied, ripe, layered Ventoux that has enough mid-palate density and fine tannin to evolve gracefully through 2024. Importer(s): Eric Solomon.
