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2014 Gómez Cruzado Pancrudo

The aromatic and perfumed 2014 Pancrudo is an unusual Garnacha, which combines aromas of ripeness with some austerity and a serious palate with signs of a cooler vintage. The grapes were sourced from diverse plots in the village of Badarán (Sierra de la Demanda, alto Najerilla) planted with old, head-pruned vines. It's mostly north-facing slopes at 650 meters altitude, in a cool zone. It shows deep flavors and good acidity, and feels nicely balanced. This is one of the most exciting new wines at this address. 3,202 bottles were produced.
