The 2015 Luberon Amo Roujo from Domaine le Novi is outstanding, and I suspect it will represent a terrific value. Made from 85% Grenache and the balance Syrah, Cinsault and Marselan, aged in tank and one- to three-year-old demi-muids, it has tons of peppery herbs and berry fruits, medium-bodied richness, no hard edges and a seamless, elegant texture. It's ideal for drinking over the coming 7-8 years.
