<p>The 2013 Aires de Vendimia is produced with Mencía grapes from very old vines fermented with 80% full clusters in an oak vat with indigenous yeasts, malolactic in barrel and 11 months élevage without any racking. If the other wines felt perfumed, this one is the absolute champion, with an unusual mix of spring flowers, violets and cold bonfire aromas, even some incense. The palate is light to medium-bodied, quite approachable. It's a nice red, but I'd never say Bierzo. 4,500 bottles produced.</p>			<b>Sweetness:</b> Dry
