I tasted again the 2013 El Sueño de Bruno, which is now within the appellation of origin Utiel-Requena. It's produced with Bobal from ancient vines on limestone soils. It felt like the wine is evolving quite fast, the aromas are quite developed and have integrated the oak quite well. But the fruit seems to be receding in the palate and some tannins remain, so I'd opt for drinking this sooner rather than later.
