Tasting Note: Deep red. The intensely perfumed nose of violet and blueberries is fragrant and fresh and very typical of the Montosoli area of Montalcino. Then broad, dense and savory, featuring a tarry element on the long back end and noteworthy insidious sweetness. Knockout stuff from a very underrated Montalcino producer that owns Sangiovese wines in Montosoli, the most famous *cru* of all Montalcino and one of its two or three best sites for the variety. Guess what? Terroir matters.
